

Mission

HISTORY

The First Friday Club of Cleveland started when a group of Catholic apostolic laymen were motivated by a call of Pope Pius XI to try to make the spirit of Christ penetrate more deeply in all family, social, economic and political life. These men suggested a local gathering of what was being called First Friday Clubs which were already functioning around the country. They felt this would give public expression to their own devotion to the Sacred Heart of Jesus by beginning a monthly forum for Catholic Christian thought. Monsignor Michael Murphy was the spiritual moderator of the group.¹

The First Friday Club of Cleveland is approaching its 67th year in existence. It has kept the format originally established, keeping the luncheon's time frame to an hour and half. It has also kept the luncheons on the Thursday before the First Friday of each month - so participants can observe the First Friday devotion. Also, with a focus on the New Evangelization which calls each of us to deepen our faith, believe in the Gospel message and go forth to proclaim the Gospel,² the First Friday of Cleveland offers opportunities to learn and reflect on our Catholic Faith with compelling presentations as well as fellowship and sharing a meal together in a faith filled environment.
